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Points to remember

- Sometimes people move from one place to another to settle there. This is called migration. The people who migrate are called migrants. Most people migrate to other places primarily for the following reasons:
 - better or higher education
 - better job opportunities
 - after marriage
 - job transfer
- Some people move to other countries permanently. This is called emigration. People who move to another country are called emigrants. Immigrants are people who arrive in a new country and settle there permanently.
- Sometimes people are forced to migrate and shift to other places. This is called displacement.
- Natural calamities like floods, famines, earthquakes and tsunamis usually result in loss of lives and property.
- Man-made calamities like wars and some political decisions also force people to move.
- Sometimes, the government breaks the houses built on unauthorized land. This is called demolition.
- When there is a war, people leave their homes to escape from violence. Sometimes they seek shelter in another country. Such people are called refugees.
- Whenever a family member moves out of the house, the whole family structure changes.
